### **Basic Developmental Program**

Schedule For the Fall 2024 season, the program will start on Sunday, September 8 and run through Sunday October 27. There will be six (6) Sundays that we play on and we have two Sundays as make-up dates, should there be a reason to postpone a day (i.e. weather issues). We will play a three week block in September (September 8, 15, and 22) and a three week block in October (October 6, 13, and 20). We will use September 29 and October 27 as make-up dates, with the first date being the make-up for the September dates and the second for the October dates. If we do not have any postponements then those dates will be off weekends. Each Sunday will consist of two parts: a 30 minute skills session followed by a game.

<u>Teams</u> Teams will not be pre-determined before the season. Each Sunday the PSC lowa coaching staff will divide the teams, after the skills session, for the games. This is done so that each player gets to play games with most, if not all, the other players in their age group. This helps the players with their social development and also limits any "competitive imbalance" to a single game instead of the entire season.

<u>Uniform</u> Each player will receive a PSC lowa Developmental shirt as part of their registration fee. This shirt will serve as their uniform for each Sunday. Each player will be required to provide their own shorts, socks, shin guards, and soccer shoes. It is requested, but not required, that players wear black shorts and black soccer socks.

**Ball** Each player is required to provide their own soccer ball. This is necessary for the skills portion of each Sunday. Each age has a specific size ball that the players will need to bring. The following table shows what size soccer ball is required, by group:

Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten (ages 4-5) - Size 3 1st Grade/2nd Grade (ages 6-7) - Size 3 2nd Grade/3rd Grade (ages 8-9) - Size 4 3rd/4th Grade (ages 10-11) - Size 4

### **Developmental Academy**

<u>Training</u> Developmental Academy teams will train from August to the end of October in the fall and mid-March (after spring break) through the first week in June for the spring season. The training sessions will be conducted at the Prairie and Kirkwood soccer fields by PSC lowa coaching staff. Each team will train at least one (1) day a week, for 75 minutes per session, with an additional optional training session for 60-75 minutes each week, with their designated PSC lowa staff coach, and have an optional second practice as well each week.

PSC lowa follows a specifically designed, age-specific, curriculum that will help the players develop their soccer skills and instill a love for the game. We will also offer playing and training options in January and February.

<u>Coaching Staff</u> All training is planned and overseen by PSC lowa's Academy Director, Michael Robertson. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including 17 years coaching college, 23 years of high school coaching, and over 13 years coaching club soccer. He holds a US Soccer National C License.

The main assistant coach to the Academy Director is Steven Robertson. Steve has an impressive background coaching soccer, including over 15 years coaching college, 25 years coaching high school, over 13 years coaching club soccer, and 5 years experience as a staff coach in the lowa ODP program. He also holds a US Soccer National C License.

All other staff coaches will complete their applicable Grass Roots license before coaching for PSC lowa.

Leagues The Developmental Academy players will participate in the PSC lowa Developmental League (PSC-DL). The PSC -DL is played on six (6) Sundays, and the dates for the Fall 2024 season are: September 8, September 15, September 22, October 6, October 13, and October 20. The make-up dates will be September 29 for the September days, and October 27 for the weekends in October.

Friendlies and Tournaments In addition to league play, the PSC lowa Developmental Academy also participates in interclub friendlies with other local soccer clubs in the Cedar Rapids area. The friendlies are a festival-style event where other U7/U8 teams from other clubs get together and play matches against each other. This allows for our Developmental Academy to get competition against other teams that have received like training and allows for much more competitive games. For the friendlies, we will play 5-a-side games with goalkeepers. We will also participate in the lowa Soccer Association League America Festival. This is a one day event and is held in Waterloo in the fall and Altoona in the spring. The cost for the tournament is part of the registration fees.

Ball Each player is required to provide their own soccer ball that they will need at every training session and on the Sunday league games. For this age, the players will need a size 3 soccer ball.
